

**CARES Amateur Radio
Training Net Script
(July 22, 2011 version 1.0)**

5 Minutes before net:

This is [Callsign]. The CARES Amateur Radio Emergency Service net will begin in 5 minutes on this repeater. If you need to make an urgent call, please do so at this time. All other stations, please refrain from normal Amateur Radio use until the conclusion of this training net in about one hour.

At Net time:

This is [Call sign – given phonetically] calling the CARES Carolinas Amateur Radio Emergency Services training net. My name is (Name – given phonetically) and I will be serving as your Net Control Station for today's net. This is a directed net, meaning the Net Control Station, or NCS, is the only operator who will direct traffic. The purpose of this net is to provide communications during emergencies between hospitals and to provide training in procedures that would apply in actual emergencies and test communications capabilities of CCHA member hospitals. All Radio Amateurs operating out of Hospitals in southeastern North Carolina and northeastern South Carolina are invited to participate in this net.

When checking into the net, please give the following in this order:

- the net control station's call sign,
- your call sign phonetically,
- your first name,
- the name of your hospital (and campus, if applicable)
- your location (city)
- whether you are with or without traffic.

Any stations having emergency, priority or time-valued traffic, please call now.

If there is any traffic, allow traffic to pass and then resume the rest of the net when control is returned to you.

Optional: If there is training. Today (*presenters call sign or name*) will provide training and information on the subject of:

We will now accept check-ins by Hospitals and their associated campuses if a hospital has more than one location. The Net Control Station will name the hospital then wait for participants from that hospital to respond. Once all check-ins from that hospital are finished, we will move to the next hospital on the list. Calling all operators at the following hospitals and supporting organizations:
