







	The unemployment rate in Brunswick County increased 37.14% from 1998-2006 and , yet remained lower than the NC rate from 2003-2006.				The number of person served in area Alcohol and Drug treatment centers in Brunswick County decreased by 12.2% from 1996-2006.
